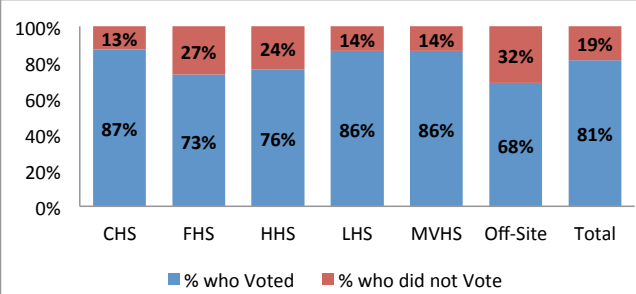


Turnout by site (number of members voting)

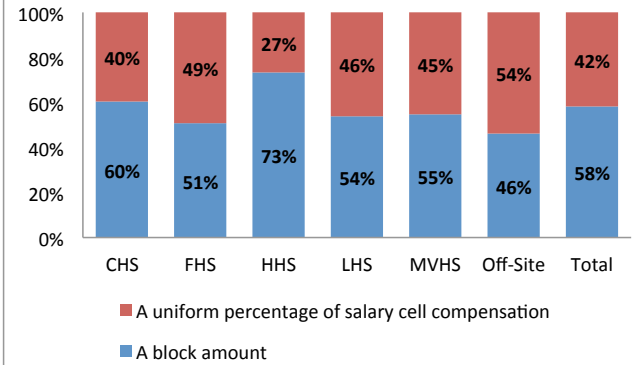

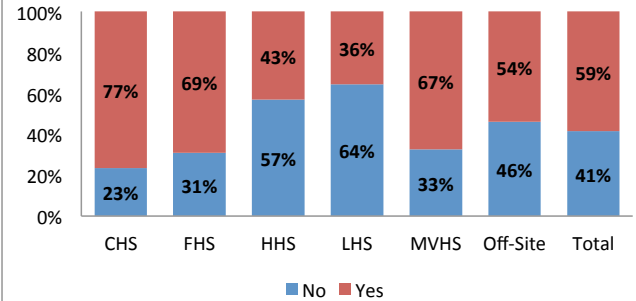
